



Code of Conduct

Every participant of Kids Camp is expected to be a good citizen, helping others whenever possible, sharing and waiting patiently for each child to have a turn.

Every child participant must listen to the Counselors and follow directions when asked to do so. The child must adhere to all safety policies outlined with each activity.

No child may leave the Camp early without a written and signed note from their parent or guardian on the day they will be leaving early. Parents and guardians may pick up children early at any time but must check in with a Counselor at that time. If any child should leave early without prior arrangements, the parent or guardian will be called, and the family will be notified that the next time will result in expulsion from Kids Camp.

Kids Camp is not a place for bullying, swearing, insulting, cursing, yelling aggressively, pushing or any other unwanted physical contact. Any dangerous behavior of this nature will result in immediate expulsion from Kids Camp with no recourse to return to camp this year.

Kids Camp is designed to be an experience of fun and friendship, where memories of Point Roberts summers are made to enjoy for a lifetime.

Kids Camp will be located at various locations around Point Roberts. The drop-off and pickup locations will be listed in the camp calendar. We will be doing 3 field trips crossing into Canada this year and we will post special instructions about those events. (Space may be limited)

Parents must fill out a Release Form, a Code of Conduct Form, and a Field Trip Form to be turned in on the first day their child attends camp. Parents **MUST** pick up their children at the end of each morning and afternoon session.
